(Uberisation/ Unbundling/ Precarity/ Disposability/ Gig Economy)










Entangling and Installing Neoliberalism in Higher Education


- ✓ Funding: linked to policy narratives/priorities

 appraisal/ search agencies/ esteem/
 reputation
- ✓ Closure of the political universe/ TINA Effect
- ✓ Performative Repetition
- **✓ Reputation** and Impression Management

(Lack of) Resistance?




Neoliberalization is generally more termitelike than lionlike (Brown 2015: 35/36)

- Capillary Power everywhere and nowhere
- Governmentality regulate ourselves
- Monetarising desires and makes us desire what is monetarised
- Sacrifice/ austerity/ regulation via finance
- *Illusi*o = investing in the game involves performativities
- Assemblage of discursive, symbolic and material rewards for those servile to the priorities of the market.

Capitalism Masquerading as Democratisation/ Participation/ Consumer Rights?




Linguistic hijacking disguises class power: choice, diversity, freedom, excellence, inclusion.

Governing Through Unhappiness




Heat Up The Floor To See Who Can Keep Hopping The Longest

Resilience




- Embracing danger/ precarity/ austerity as inevitable.
