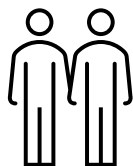

First, set up your **name badge**. Here you can display your contact details, research/professional interests, and link to your social media pages.

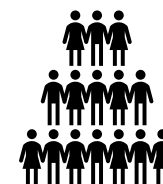
Once your name badge is set up, you can access the event chat which involves all delegates who have their name badges set up. You can also:



Direct message an individual conference delegate



Create a **private group chat**. Participation in this kind of chat is by invitation only. Private group chats can be a useful way to carry on discussions following a presentation session, or to have a group discussion about a specific shared interest



Create a **public group chat**. Delegates can opt to join this kind of chat of their own accord
